

## TCHC Tenant Council Election: Assisted Voting Declaration

This declaration must be completed if an individual assists a TCHC tenant to vote during the Tenant Council Election.

- A voter is a resident or tenant of Toronto Community Housing Corporation (TCHC) who has verified their residency and is eligible to participate in the TCHC Tenant Council Election.
- An assistant is an individual—such as a family member, friend, support
  worker, or fellow tenant—who has been requested and has agreed to
  support a voter in participating in the election at a designated polling
  location.
- All assistants, including interpreters, are required to complete a declaration form when assisting a voter.
- An election official may serve as an assistant to a tenant; however, they
  are not required to complete the declaration form.

By signing this declaration, you confirm that:

- The assistant is neither a scrutineer nor a candidate in the TCHC Tenant Council Election.
- To the best of the voter's knowledge, the assistant has not previously assisted any other tenant in the community during this election.
- The voter provides informed consent for the assistant to support them in the voting process at the polling station.
