### Discover deputation

Learn about deputation, why it is important, and how to get involved.

### What is deputation?

A deputation is a written or verbal **presentation** made by tenants, staff, or members of the public to the Toronto Community Housing (TCHC) **Board of Directors** (the Board) or one of its **Committees**. Deputations must be related to a topic that is on the **public Agenda** for the meeting.

### Why you should depute

- **Have a say.** Deputation gives you the opportunity to have a say in the decisions that impact you and your community.
- **Make a difference.** When you depute, you help shape policy decisions that can
