Registry - Autism 1, Registry - Vulnerable Person 4

As an autistic person, I am quite concerned that Toronto Community Housing Corporation has an autism registry and considers this to be an incident. I did not even realize Toronto had an autism registry separate from the Toronto Police Service's Vulnerable Persons Registry. Please stop considering autistic people like myself to be a liability. Please also develop a NeuroAffirming Committee and a NeuroInclusion Team that would consist of neurodivergent tenants to help support other tenants, instead of considering people like myself a pest and an inconvenience.

274 complaints about animal noise, two bear complaints, 242 Dog Owners Liability Act complaints, 6 animals left in vehicles, 135 Master Code animal complaints (whatever that means), 237 Other Animal Complaints, Animal - Bear Complaint 2, Animal - Dog Owners Liability Act 242, Animal - Left in Vehicle 6, Animal - Master Code 135, Animal - Other 237, Animal Bite 39, Animal Injured 12, Animal Stray 15. Causing unnecessary suffering to Animals 4, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act - Other 3, Injuring/endangering Animals 4, Mouse complaints 8368

And yet, no Canine Encounter Training and no Bear Encounter Training whatsoever for the special constables. These encounters should be managed and even prevented by having an Animal Tenants And Neighbours Committee. Replace the Breed Species enforcement of the Dog Owners Liability Act with local breed neutral bylaw enforcement by Toronto Animal Services. Breed Specific Legislation does not work.
